MEMBERSHIP OF PGNA

“**Psychogeriatric** refers to that field of health whose primary focus is the mental and cognitive wellbeing of the older person - the older person usually being of age 65 years or older.” (PGNA Constitution & Rules 1.3.1)

“A **Psychogeriatric Nurse** is a registered or enrolled nurse whose practice - regardless of whether this is in the clinical, management, or academic setting - is focused on the older person with a mental illness and/or a cognitive impairment.” (PGNA Constitution & Rules 1.3.2)

PGNA Purpose is to:

- Encourage and provide an avenue for personal and professional communication between psychogeriatric nurses.
- Encourage the exchange and dissemination of knowledge, skills, and ideas in the field of psychogeriatric nursing.
- Provide opportunities for continuing education by means of written articles, lectures and seminars.
- Develop psychogeriatric nursing as a discipline.
- Foster the highest standards of psychogeriatric nursing care.
- Encourage clinical research in the field of psychogeriatrics.
- Promote interrelationships between other branches of the nursing profession.
- Promote links between other professional bodies at regional, state, national and international levels.
- Provide a united and authoritative voice for the profession of nursing on all matters pertaining to the clinical specialty of psychogeriatric nursing.
- Affiliate with other nursing, medical, and other professional groups.
(PGNA Constitution & Rules 1.2 et sequitur)

PGNA activity includes:

- Organising Conferences and Education Evenings.
- Offering scholarships to full voting members who have been financial for at least 12 months for the purpose of attending relevant conferences and/or completing relevant post-graduate courses and/or relevant research projects.
- Publishing a Newsletter for members.

PGNA Membership:

- **Class 1 - Full Voting Membership** - this is available to any person who is a registered or enrolled nurse primarily engaged in, or with an interest in, psychogeriatric nursing. (PGNA Constitution & Rules 2.1)
- **Class 2 - Associate Non-Voting Membership** - this is available to any other health care worker or professional person who has an interest in psychogeriatric nursing. (PGNA Constitution & Rules 2.2)
- **Class 3 - Life Membership** - the Executive Committee may from time to time confer life membership upon Class 1 members who have, by their efforts, consistently promoted the interests and progression of the Association.
(PGNA Constitution & Rules 2.3)

Payment of PGNA Membership and Associate Membership Fees:

- **Full Voting Membership** - The current annual fee is \$40
- **Associate Non-Voting Membership** - The current annual fee is \$20
- **Life Membership** - no fee attaches.
- The annual fee covers the calendar year from 1st July to 30th June in the next calendar year.
- Payment of the annual fee is made only to the Membership Secretary of PGNA
- Fee payments are to be by cheque or Post Office money order form and must accompany the completed Membership Application / Renewal of Membership Form (see the reverse of this page). For reasons of fiduciary accountability **no cash payments** will be received by the Membership Secretary of PGNA.
- Fee payments can also be made by Direct Debit. Please contact the PGNA Secretary or Treasurer for the BSB and account numbers. Please see the PGNA website for contact details.
- Please print receipt from Direct Debit payments and post with completed membership form.
- Upon payment of the annual fee a numbered receipt will be issued by the Membership Secretary of PGNA and new members / associate members will also be issued with a hardcopy edition of PGNA Constitution & Rules.
- One only reminder-of-renewal notice for each calendar year will be issued to members / associate members.
- Financial membership / associate membership ceases if not renewed one month after issue of renewal notice.
